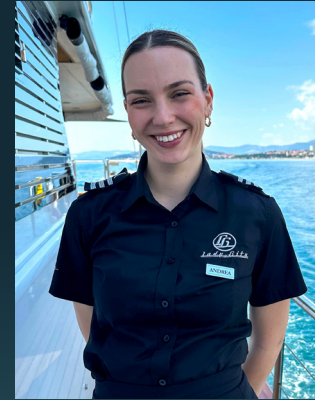


Marina Saskor
